Local nurses and community invited to share their experience

Tampa, Fla. - The <u>Florida Center for Nursing</u> (FCN) is conducting a statewide Community Engagement Tour. The Northeast regional workshop will take place on July 11th, 3:30pm, at the University of North Florida, 3:30pm-5:40pm.

The Community Engagement Tour is a series of regional workshops that allow the community to review and comment on nursing workforce data. In addition, participants have the opportunity to offer input on the needs specific to their community and recommend systemic changes, including strategies for implementation. The workshops are an opportunity for the Florida Center for Nursing, health care leaders, educators, and lawmakers to hear directly from the community about issues impacting health care in the region and across the state.
