1. Welcome & Review of Agenda Items

Dr. Rayna Letourneau reviewed agenda items.

2. Approval of May 2026 Meeting Minutes

No revisions to the May 14, 2026, meeting minutes were requested by members.

3. FCN Update: Synergy in Nursing Symposium

Dr. Letourneau announced a new statewide nursing education symposium, *Synergy in Nursing: Uniting Classroom and Clinic for Florida's Future*, developed in partnership with Florida Organization for Associate Degree Nursing (FOADN) and Florida Council of Nursing Education Administrators (FCNEA) under Dr. Patricia Gagliano's leadership. The two-day symposium will focus on professional development for associate-level nursing faculty.

4. Evidence-Based and Innovative Strategies Discussion

The Board discussed evidence-based and innovative strategies to support nurse well-being across settings and career stages, with a focus on identifying the Board's top priorities for FY27. Members identified priorities for FCN consideration, including nurse retention, statewide baseline well-being data, career-advancement pathways for direct-care nurses, mentorship and nurse-coaching models, workplace violence and safety, and a statewide nurse well-being and workforce report. The Board identified retention,

workplace violence and safety, and a statewide well-being and workforce report as its top three priorities for FY27.
